



OUR OFFICIAL TRADEMARK

The Trademark of the International Order of Job's Daughters consists of a double triangle enclosing a replica of three girls wearing robes and crowns, holding cornucopia, dove, and urn within the inner triangle, and the words 'IYOB FILIAE' at the base between the inner and outer triangle, and the ® symbol in the lower right hand corner of the triangle. This is the OFFICIAL EMBLEM.

Bethel use is confined to stationery, programs, invitations, and bylaws. Grand Guardian Councils may use the TRADEMARK for stationery, programs, invitations, manuals, and for the printing of forms used within their Grand Guardian Council.

Permission for the use of the TRADE for PURPOSES OTHER THAN THOSE SPECIFIED, must be obtained from the member of the Supreme Guardian Council Board of Trustees in charge of the TRADEMARK. Such permission is granted by the Board of Trustees when in compliance with the accepted rules and regulations of the Board.

The Guardian Secretary of each Bethel has jewelry order blanks imprinted with the name and address of the Official Jeweler for your locality. The use of our TRADEMARK has been authorized by the Board of Trustees to such Official Jewelers.
